Students are to complete either a non-fiction or a fiction book report that includes each of the following requirements.

## Non-fiction

- Title
- Author
- 5 interesting facts you learned
- At least 1 illustration
- Answer the following questions in complete sentences:
  - Why did you choose this book?
  - Who would you recommend this book to and why?

## Fiction

- Title
- Author
- Character
- Setting
- Summary
- Compare yourself to the main character in the story.
- Who would you recommend this book to and why?

Students are encouraged to be creative when creating their projects! Posters, books, trifolds, power points, prezis, -nothing is off limits as long as they include the necessary information!
